2022 WCCC COVID-19 Response and Protocols

The precautionary measures below will be implemented for the health and safety of all WCCC attendees.

1. Masks will be worn by all attendees in all indoor spaces.
2. Wash hands often with soap and water or sanitize hands.
3. Hand sanitizers will be readily available at conference area space used by attendees.
4. When sneezing or coughing, cover the mouth and nose with a tissue. Discard used tissues in trash and wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.
5. During the conference, all attendees are asked to self-monitor for signs and COVID-19 symptoms (such as fever, coughing, muscle aches, runny nose, sore throat, headache, and shortness of breath). A. REGISTRATION / SERVICE DESK

B. CAMPUS PARKING

1. Parking is permitted in all General Parking lots (Lot E, F, G, H, J, L, M, N and O).

2. Parking permits are required for campus parking 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. A valid parking permit must always be displayed on the vehicle's dashboard.
3. Parking permits are issued at the Registration/Service Desk.
4. Please observe all traffic and parking regulations. Violators will be personally responsible for payment of fines. The Conference will not bear the financial responsibility for any violation fines.

C. ACCOMMODATIONS

1. The University does not allow any room changes.
2. 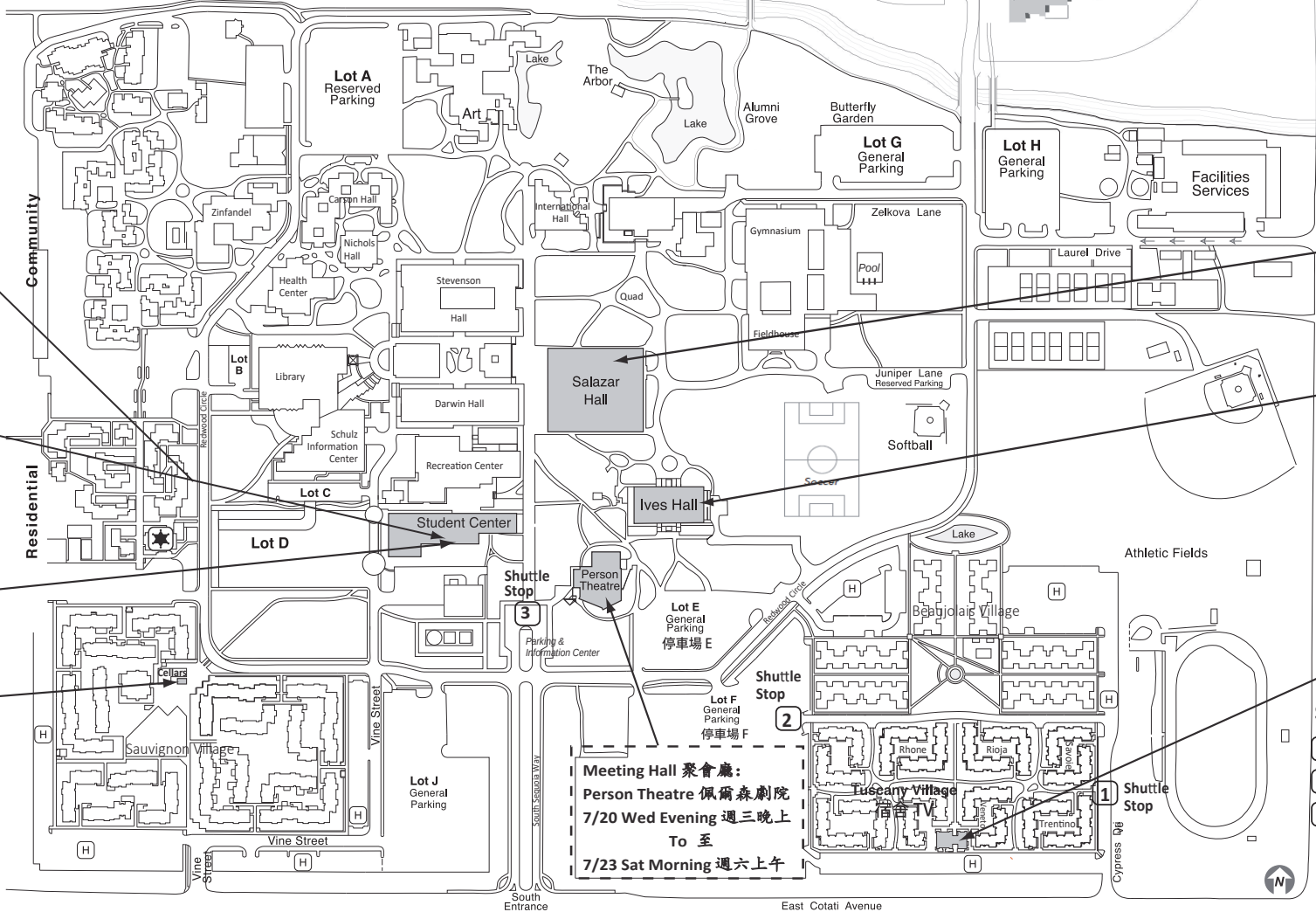
